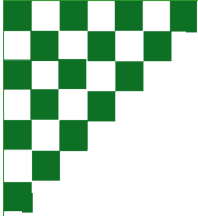

Second edition for Little Big Mans. After a huge success in 2008, the young drivers are back on the track, more motivated than ever to show off their talent. As the organisation is the same for the children as for the adults, an entry list is published. Here is the first one.

On Saturday, 10th of July at 2pm, some 100 boys and girls, from 6 to 13 years old will be on the Le Mans circuit behind the wheels of their mini racing cars.

Admired by 100 000 spectators crowded in the grandstands behind the starting line, the Little Big Mans children are guaranteed to provide a dazzling start-off for the Le Mans Classic races.

The start of this race-parade will be given *Le Mans* style. The children run towards their cars before taking off for a complete lap of the Bugatti circuit.

The mini-cars on the track, equipped with heat or electric engines, represent the prestigious history of motor sports with models such as Ferrari 330 P2, Lotus 7, Ford GT40, Alpine A 220, Bugatti T35 or Aston Martin Volante Junior...46 cars are already entered to this day and the Organisation has no more cars to rent! To participate from now on, you will have to come with your own car (1/2 scale)!

Some competitors do not hesitate to cross the oceans to join this mythical and touching moment. 10 different nationalities are present on the entry list to this day, among them Columbians, New Zealanders, Cypriots but also French, English, Germans or Belgians...in short... children from all around the world !

As their elders, the junior drivers will have a private paddock, in which the public can admire all the entered cars. The prize giving ceremony rewards all the budding drivers thanks to the Little Big Mans partners: Matmut & Optic 2000.
